## Wanneroo Regional Modelling (2008)



The State Government has made funds available to the Department for Planning and Infrastructure to assist local governments with land release and to facilitate housing development. The employment self-sufficiency target of 72% as per the 1992 North-West Corridor Structure Plan has been extremely challenging to achieve.

Strategies to achieve the desired employment profile through surveys, gap analysis, supply chain completion and investment attraction will be developed for the corridor and individual centres, which include Joondalup, Neerabup, Yanchep, Alkimos-Eglinton and Wanneroo. Population projections and centre economic profiles will enable employment self-sufficiency to be calculated on a corridor-wide basis, through determining each centre's contribution to sustainability over time.

### Outcomes

The project will deliver two key outcomes, namely the five regional activity models with activity centre-specific population and employment (number by occupation and industry) estimates for 2011, 2016, 2021, 2026 and 2031. The second outcome is a supplementary report that comments on the economic sustainability of the proposed centres at each planning interval.
