Following on from the workforce accommodation modelling, Pracsys has assisted Hamersley Iron (now Rio Tinto) to identify the servicing requirements for 300 new houses to be built in Tom Price and Paraburdoo.

Pracsys used the forecasts of workforce, accommodation and population to estimate the type and magnitude of changes to the local economy and to identify critical items of service and infrastructure that are required to support the

expansion strategy.

Outcome

Once implemented, the resulting strategy will guide the development of a balanced and fully functional micro-economy to enable Hamersley Iron to attract and retain a high quality workforce with appropriate standards of accommodation, community services, retail shopping and infrastructure.
