
Economic Development Options



Mineral sands mining operations have existed at Eneabba for about 30 years. Iluka Resources has advised the Shire of Carnamah that it expects to significantly scale back its mineral sands operations in Eneabba within the next five to ten years. As the major employer in the community the departure of Iluka will have a major impact on the local economy. Recognising the problem, the Shire of Carnamah and the Eneabba community are keen to

explore alternatives to economic development for the area, to diversify the regional economy and offset the negative impacts of the departure of the area's major employer.

Pracsys has been engaged to review economic development options across a diverse range of industries and commercial categories. Pracsys is developing a rating matrix for development options which will identify the preferred projects. Following this Pracsys will conduct high level pre-feasibility analysis on the chosen options and estimate the likely impacts on the community from developing these projects in or near Eneabba.

Outcome

The Shire of Carnamah and the Eneabba community will have a clear understanding of the strategic opportunities for the economic development of the community. The community will also have a clearly defined action plan providing direction on how it can assist or facilitate project development in the area.
