
Subiaco Markets Feasibility Study



The Subiaco Redevelopment Authority (SRA) has identified economic activation as one of its key roles in inner-city Perth. The SRA commissioned Pracsys to determine the feasibility of a new Farmers Market around the Subiaco Train Station. SRA and the City of Subiaco have considered the Farmers Markets business plan and are seeking a suitable operator and key sponsor for the venture. The timing of the venture is critical and preparations are underway to launch the markets to correspond

with the closure of the existing market sites. It is expected that a Regional Growers Market would contribute to the vitality of the Station Square Precinct, by acting as a unique draw card, attracting more customers for the potential of all businesses.
