About the fund

The Department of Infrastructure and Regional Development has set aside \$297.7 million for a new competitive grants program - the **Building Better Regions Fund**. There are two streams of funding available under the program, the Infrastructure Projects Stream and the Community Investments Stream, which is designed to fund non-infrastructure projects that deliver economic and social benefits to regional and remote communities.

A successful application needs quantified evidence that addresses the following merit criteria:

- Economic Benefit
- Social Benefit
- Value for Money
- Capacity, Capability and Resources
