The City of Karratha is committed to creating an iconic statement through the proposed Karratha Arts and Community precinct, which will include a new theatre, library and community facilities, rooftop cinema, outdoor amphitheatre and function spaces.

Whilst unsuccessful in Round One of the National Stronger Regions Fund (NSRF), the

City of Karratha engaged a multi-disciplinary team of Consultants to provide input into Round Two of the NSRF.

Pracsys was commissioned to assist the City of Karratha in assessing the economic impacts of the Karratha Arts and Community Precinct. Pracsys provided economic analysis surrounding the following criteria:

- The extent to which the project contributes to economic growth within the region
- The extent to which the project supports or addresses disadvantage in the region
- The extent to which the project increases investment and builds partnerships in the region

Outcomes: The City of Karratha was successful in securing \$10,000,000 from the NSRF in support of this project.
